FALL 2002 ENROLLMENT SUMMARY

Executive Summary

This report summarizes the status and trends in fall enrollment at the University of Missouri's four campuses. Enrollments are presented in a series of six tables. Table 1a summarizes the first-time on-campus headcount by student level for each campus since 1998. Table 1b summarizes the fall total headcount enrollments for each campus and the System for the same time period. Table 2 displays fall 2002 enrollments by campus, student level, and characteristics such as residency, full- and part-time status, and student full-time equivalency. Following Tables 1a-b and Table 2 are a series of tables displaying more detailed enrollment and student characteristics for the System and each individual campus. Tables 3.0-3.4 depict on-campus and off-campus headcount and full-time equivalency enrollments as well as student credit hours by student level. On-campus and off-campus enrollments by residency, full- and part-time status, and student level are shown in Tables 4.0-4.4. Table 5.0 shows enrollments by student level, gender, and ethnic characteristics, and Table 6.0 displays UMKC headcount enrollment in its six-year dentistry and medicine programs.

The highlights of the report include:

- The University of Missouri System enrolled a record 60,903 students in Fall 2002. This was an increase of 8% from Fall 2001 and an increase of 12% over the past 5 years.
- From Fall 2001, total undergraduate enrollment increased from 42,737 to 45,132, an increase of 6%.
- Total on-campus first-time student headcount increased 5% from Fall 2001.
- The University of Missouri System enrolled a total 39,865 full-time and 21,038 part-time students in Fall 2002.
- Eighty-one percent of all students enrolled at the University of Missouri System are Missouri residents.

Technical Notes

These tables provide counts of students enrolled in the fall of 2002 on-schedule credit courses of the four campuses of the University of Missouri. Fall 2001 counts are included in the Table 3 series (3.0-3.4) for comparison purposes. The data included in these tables were prepared in the admissions and registration offices at the respective campuses. The data are counts as of the census data at each campus, which is defined as the end of the fourth week of classes for the fall session. The reports were generally based on the reporting guidelines and definitions of the Coordinating Board for Higher Education (CBHE) and the National Center for Educational Statistics (NCES).

Each of the tables in the Table 3 and Table 4 series include counts of on- and off-campus students. The columns titled "On-Campus", according to the CBHE guidelines, include students enrolled geographically on campus and students in the Graduate Engineering (Residence) Centers. All other students are counted in the columns headed "Off-Campus", which include students enrolled in extension courses and students that receive H.S advanced credit from the Kansas City and St. Louis campuses. The tables of the Table 3 series also include full-time equivalence (FTE) counts. FTE is defined as 15 semester credit hours for undergraduates and 12 semester credit hours for graduates. For professional programs, FTE is defined as 15 semester hours for Law, 18 for UM Columbia Medicine, and 16 for Veterinary Medicine. For Dentistry, UMKC Medicine, Optometry, and Pharmacy, FTE is equal to headcount.

Caveats

First- and second-year students in the Dentistry DDS and Medicine MD programs at UMKC are included in the undergraduate counts of the Table 3 and Table 4 series. For this reason, headcount enrollments for students at all years in these two programs are summarized in Table 6.

Enrollment counts for students in "Off-Schedule" courses, which include intersession courses, short courses, Video Credit courses, and other courses which begin and end on dates other than those for the regular academic semester, are accumulated during the term in which the courses began and are reported the semester following their end date.

Students enrolled in the Center for Independent Study and the MU Direct programs on the Columbia campus are included in this report for the first time, and are counted in the off-campus column of table 3.1. Percent changes of greater than 100% in table 3.1 reflect the inclusion of these students in this report for the first-time. Subsequently, a significant portion of the 42% increase in off-campus headcount on the UM System total page (table 3.0) is attributed to the off-campus headcount of the Columbia campus.

Tables 1a, 1b and 2: Fall Enrollment History and Summary of Fall 2002 Enrollments

- The University of Missouri had a record total enrollment of 60,903 in fall of 2002. This is a 12% increase in enrollment over the past five years.
- UM-Columbia enrolled 42.9% (26,124 students) of total students at the University of Missouri, UM-St. Louis 25.7% (15,658 students), UM-Kansas City 22.8% (13,881 students), and UM-Rolla 8.6% (5,240 students).
- The University of Missouri enrolled 45,132 undergraduate students (74% of total headcount), 2,748 first professional students (5%), and 13,023 graduate students (21%).
- Eighty-one percent of all students enrolled at the University are Missouri residents.
- Of the 60,903 students enrolled System-wide, 65% are full-time students.

- Total headcount enrollment at the University increased 8% from 56,512 in fall 2001 to 60,903 in Fall 2002.
- Undergraduate enrollment increased 6%, graduate enrollment increased by 18%, and first professional enrollment increased by 1% from Fall 2001. A significant portion of the increase in graduate enrollment is due to including Center for Independent Study and MU Direct students in the Columbia campus headcount for the first time.
- The number of first-time degree seeking freshmen enrolling at the University of Missouri increased by 257 students over fall 2001, an increase of 4%.
- First-time degree seeking graduate students totaled 2,728, an increase of 12% from Fall 2001.
- The total FTE enrollments and SCH produced increased by 7% and 6%, respectively.

- Total headcount enrollment at UM-Columbia increased 10% (2,457 students) from 23,667 in Fall 2001 to 26,124 in Fall 2002. Over half of this increase was due to including Center for Independent Study and MU direct students in the fall headcount for the first time.
- First-time degree seeking freshman enrollment was 4,439, an increase of 7% from Fall 2001.
- First-time first professional enrollment decreased 9% from the previous year and graduate degree seeking enrollment increased by 15%.
- When all levels were combined, FTE enrollment and SCH produced increased 8% and 7%, respectively.

- Total headcount enrollment at UM-Kansas City was 13,881 in Fall 2002, a 7% increase over the total of 12,969 in Fall 2001. FTE enrollment rose by 8% during the last year.
- Total undergraduate enrollment increased by 7%, graduate enrollment increased by 9% and first-professional enrollment increased by 4% from Fall 2001.
- Enrollment of first-time degree seeking freshmen increased by only 7 students or 1% over Fall 2001.

- Total headcount enrollment at UM-Rolla increased from 4,883 students in Fall 2001 to 5,240 students in Fall 2002, an increase of 7% from the previous year.
- The number of first-time degree seeking freshmen increased by 93 students from last year, an increase of 13% from Fall 2001.
- The number of first-time graduate degree seeking students was 400, an increase of 22% from Fall 2001.
- Total FTE enrollment and SCH produced increased by 4% at the undergraduate level while there was a 28% increase at the graduate level.

- At the undergraduate level, 75% of degree seeking freshmen and sophomores were enrolled full-time, compared to 55% of degree seeking juniors and seniors. Only 21% of graduate students were enrolled full-time.
- Ninety-five percent of undergraduates at UM-St. Louis were Missouri residents, while 83% of graduate students were residents. Of the 158 first professional students, 58% were residents of Missouri.

- Total enrollment at the University of Missouri was 54% women and 46% men in Fall 2002. UM-St. Louis had the largest percentage of women (61%) and UM-Rolla had the highest proportion of men (78%).
- With the exception of first-time degree-seeking freshmen, women comprised the majority of students at all levels of enrollment at the University of Missouri.
- Under-represented minorities (American Indian/Alaskan Native, African-American, and Hispanic) represented 11% of the University of Missouri's total enrollment. Under-represented minorities comprised 15% of the total enrollment at UM-Kansas City and 13% at UM-St. Louis. Eight percent of students enrolled at UM-Columbia were from under-represented groups as were 6% of the students enrolled at UM-Rolla.
- UM-St. Louis had an African-American enrollment of 1,850 students, 12% of its total, and the largest percentage among the four campuses.
- UM-Kansas City enrolled higher percentages of Asian/Pacific Islanders and Hispanics than the other four campuses at 5% and 3% respectively.
- Although nonresident aliens comprised only 6% of total enrollment at the University of Missouri, they represented 21% of the total graduate enrollment. UM-Rolla enrolls the largest percentage of nonresident alien graduate students (52%).
