Foreword to Summary Report  
*Mun Y. Choi, UM System President*

At the December 2017 Board of Curators meeting, we shared recommendations following an administrative review process, which identified opportunities to reduce costs and invest in activities that support our students, faculty and staff. We also articulated the need for the institution to reflect and to replace ‘business as usual’ approaches with transformations to reinvest, sustain and grow the areas that support our core mission as a public higher education institution.

The landscape of higher education is changing across the country and continues to face financial challenges. The University cannot persist in its current mode, nor can opportunities identified during the administrative review process be allowed to languish given the challenges that we face. The people who comprise our University are woven in to all its efforts. Understanding those efforts through a context of our people is a critical component for any considerations of our future as an organization.

From February 16 to March 2, 2018, we conducted an Activity Analysis survey designed to understand the depth and breadth of our organization and the activities of our people. With a response rate of over 96%, this comprehensive data will be used to help the University understand and transform its operations. There were more than 16,000 staff who participated in this analysis. The attached *Activity Analysis Survey Summary Report* is the result of those responses.

The information in this report tells us about positions involved in administrative work and how much is being done, but does not provide us with a view of how well or how important a specific activity is performed. Our external environment requires a level of change that will require us to evaluate questions of “how important” and “how well” through a new lens—a lens that is much different from how we evaluated things in the past.

We know the University will need to transform in order meet its mission and to become a stronger university. But, it is incumbent upon us to decide exactly how to move forward in order to improve. The changes we seek through this study will enable the University to better achieve its mission to educate the next generation of students, solve grand challenge problems through groundbreaking research and effectively engage with citizens in Missouri and beyond.

Some important change efforts are already underway and will continue to grow as we set that long-term vision for our institution. With the availability of this information, I have designated responsible parties across the organization to serve as lead roles over data for a respective function and tasked each to dive deeper and use the data to affect necessary and positive change within the organization.

There is still tough work for us ahead, but we remain committed to transparency, collaboration and accountability. Each voice within our University community is integral to this process. I thank everyone who participated and supported the Activity Analysis survey in sharing that voice, and I look forward to our continued discussions around the transformation of our administrative functions.

# Activity Analysis Overview

# Activity Analysis Overview

- The Activity Analysis survey was a study of the distribution of administrative work being done by staff across the University.
  - Staff (full-time and part-time) across all business units, including students who perform administrative work, were included in the survey.
  - Faculty (individuals with primary academic appointments), MU Health employees who report organizationally to the hospital and graduate assistants (GTAs/GRAs) were not included in the survey.
  - Survey population was a snapshot of in-scope active employees as of February 13, 2018.
- The survey collected information on staff workload across a variety of work functions.
  - The survey was organized based on the type of work being performed, not where in the organizational structure the work was being conducted.
  - The survey measured work effort information across three levels:
    - **Functions:** High-level areas of business (e.g. Finance)
    - **Processes:** Categories of tasks within each Function (e.g. Accounts Payable)
    - **Activities:** Individual activities or tasks housed within each Process (e.g. Check Processing)
  - Participants allocated their work time over a year in percentages, based on their position in its current capacity.
  - Information about the survey structure and definitions of the different functions, processes and activities are available in an [information supplement](#) separate to this report.
- The survey was open from February 19 to March 2, 2018.
- The University achieved a 96% completion rate with 16,698 unique position responses, equivalent to 11,812 FTEs.

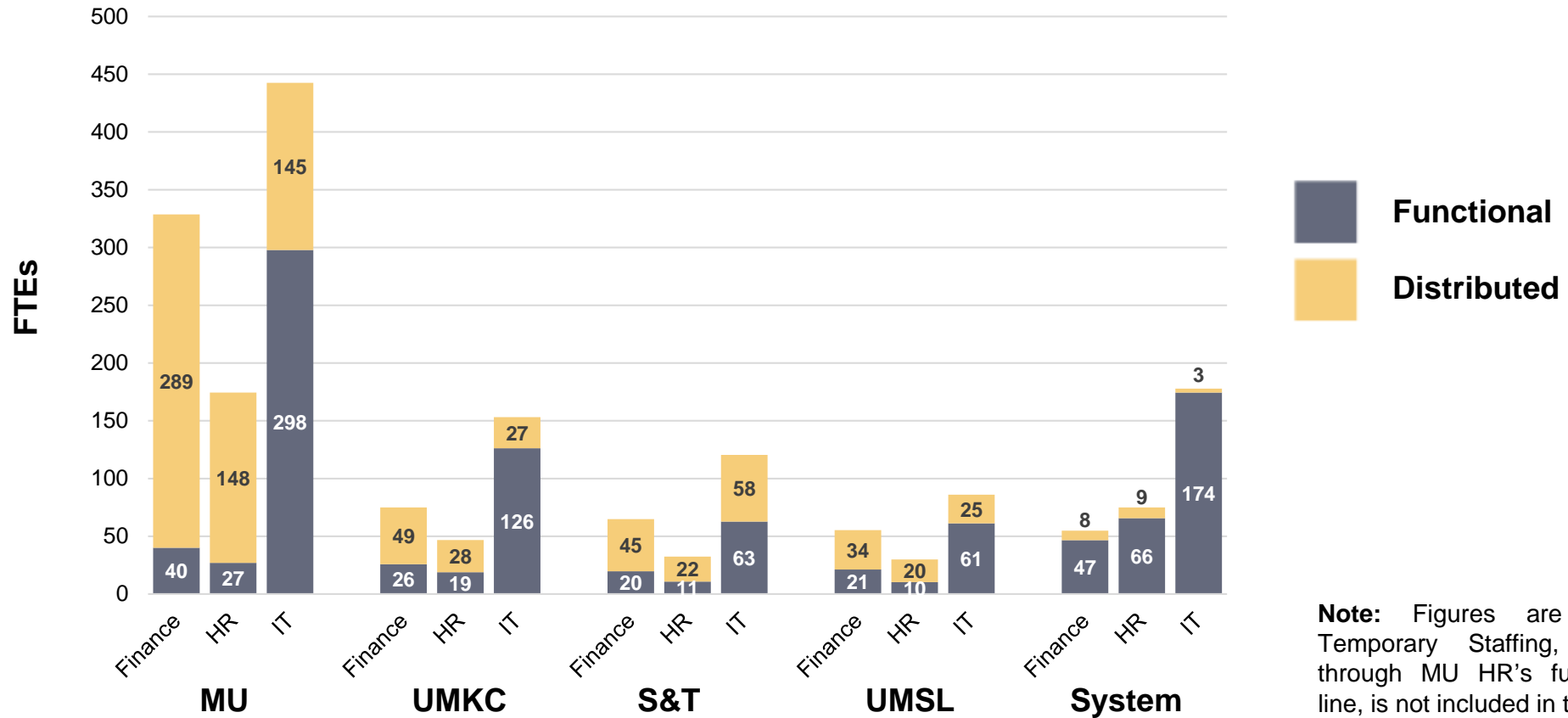

# Functional and Distributed FTEs By Organizational Unit

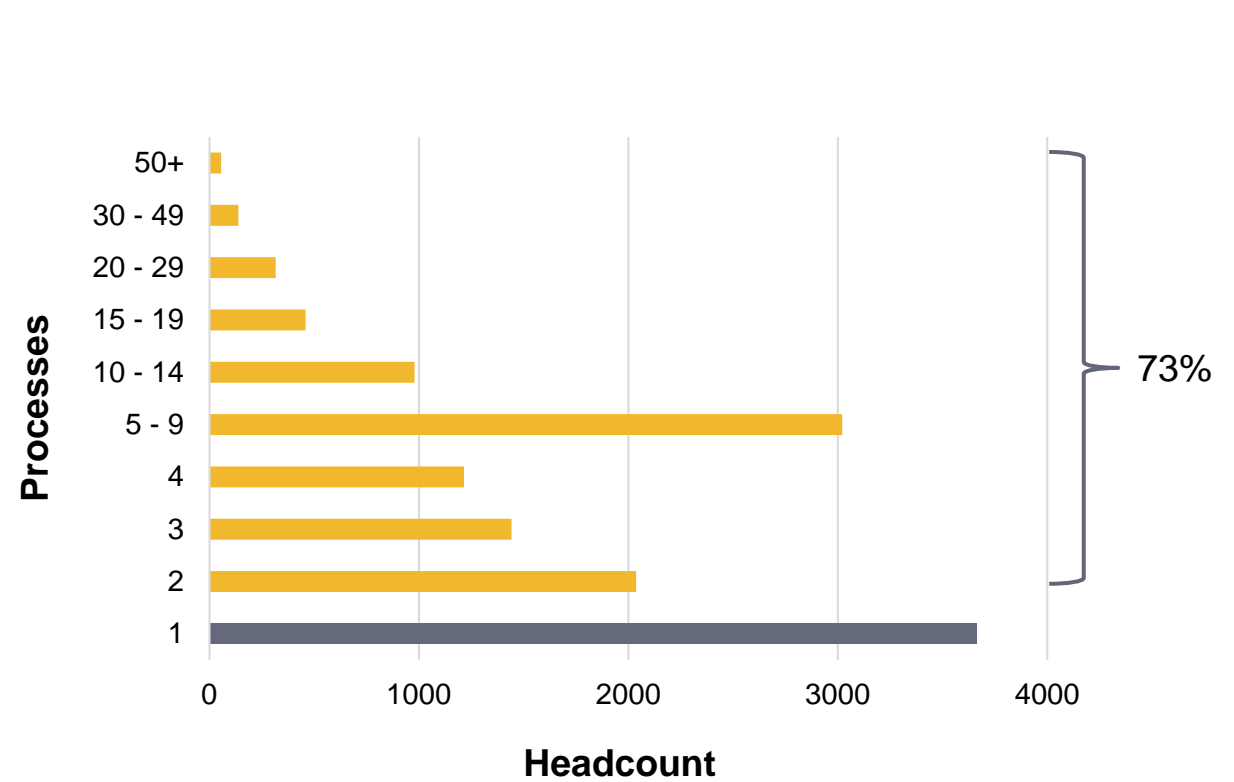
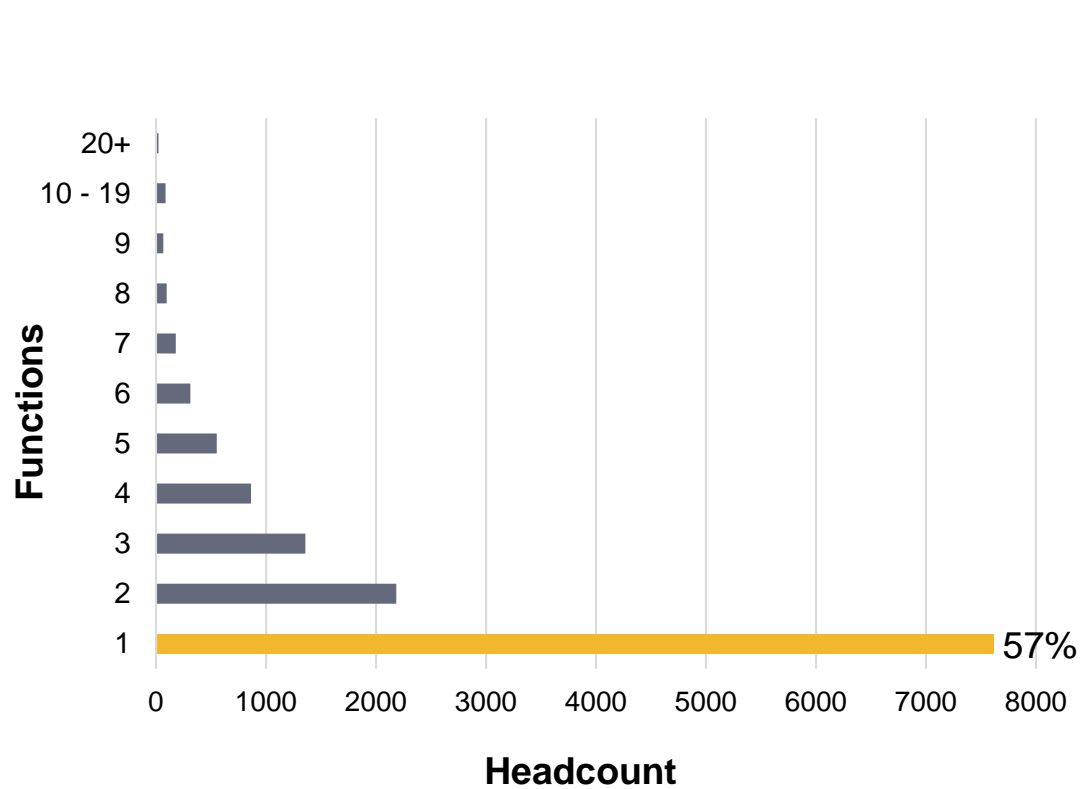
Across the organization, Finance and HR work is managed primarily outside of functional reporting lines, while IT efforts are primarily managed within the IT functional reporting lines.

# Number of Functions/Processes Selected

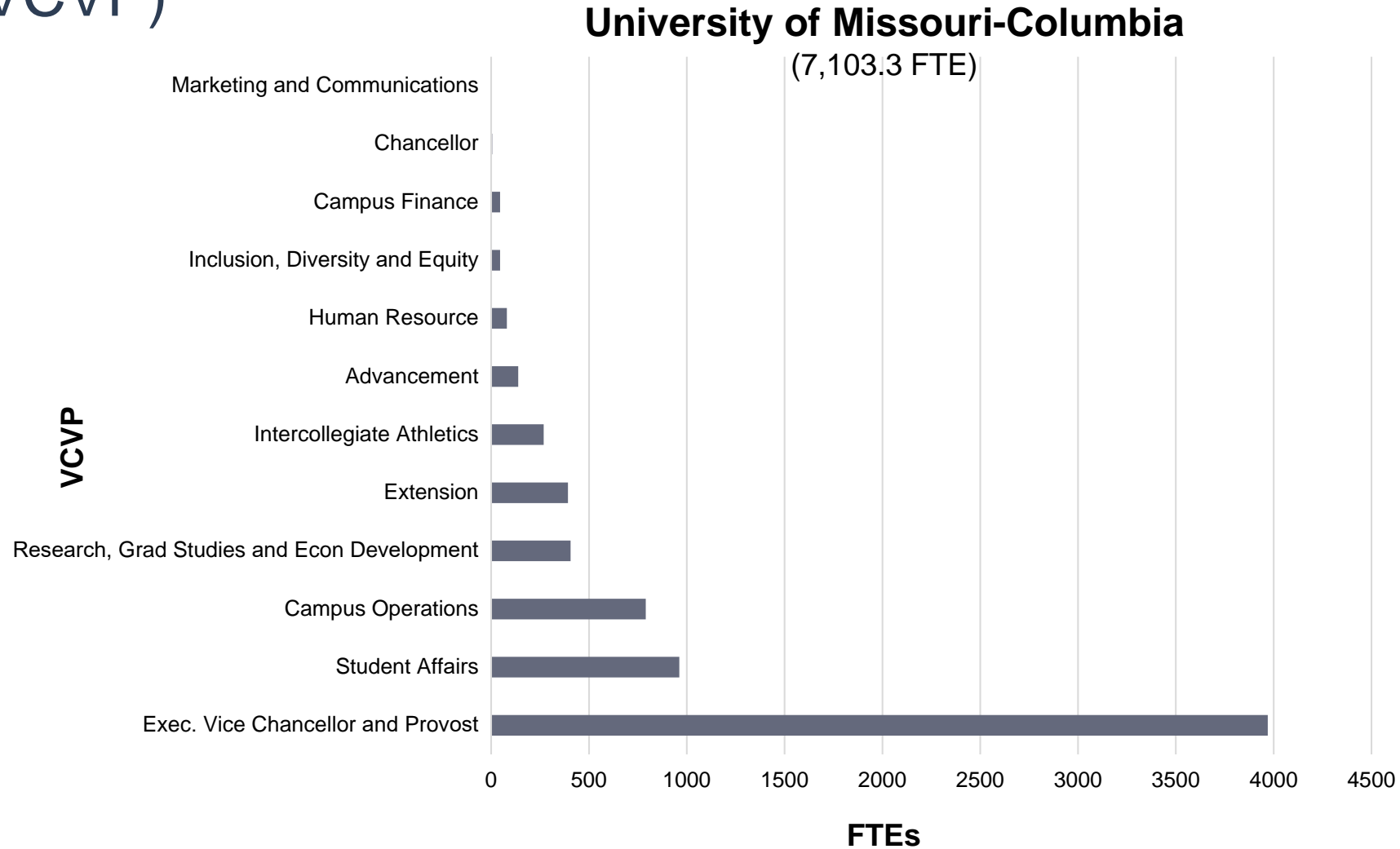
Across the organization, 57% of staff members only selected one Function, demonstrating focused functional work effort, but within Functions, 73% of people are spread out across multiple Processes.

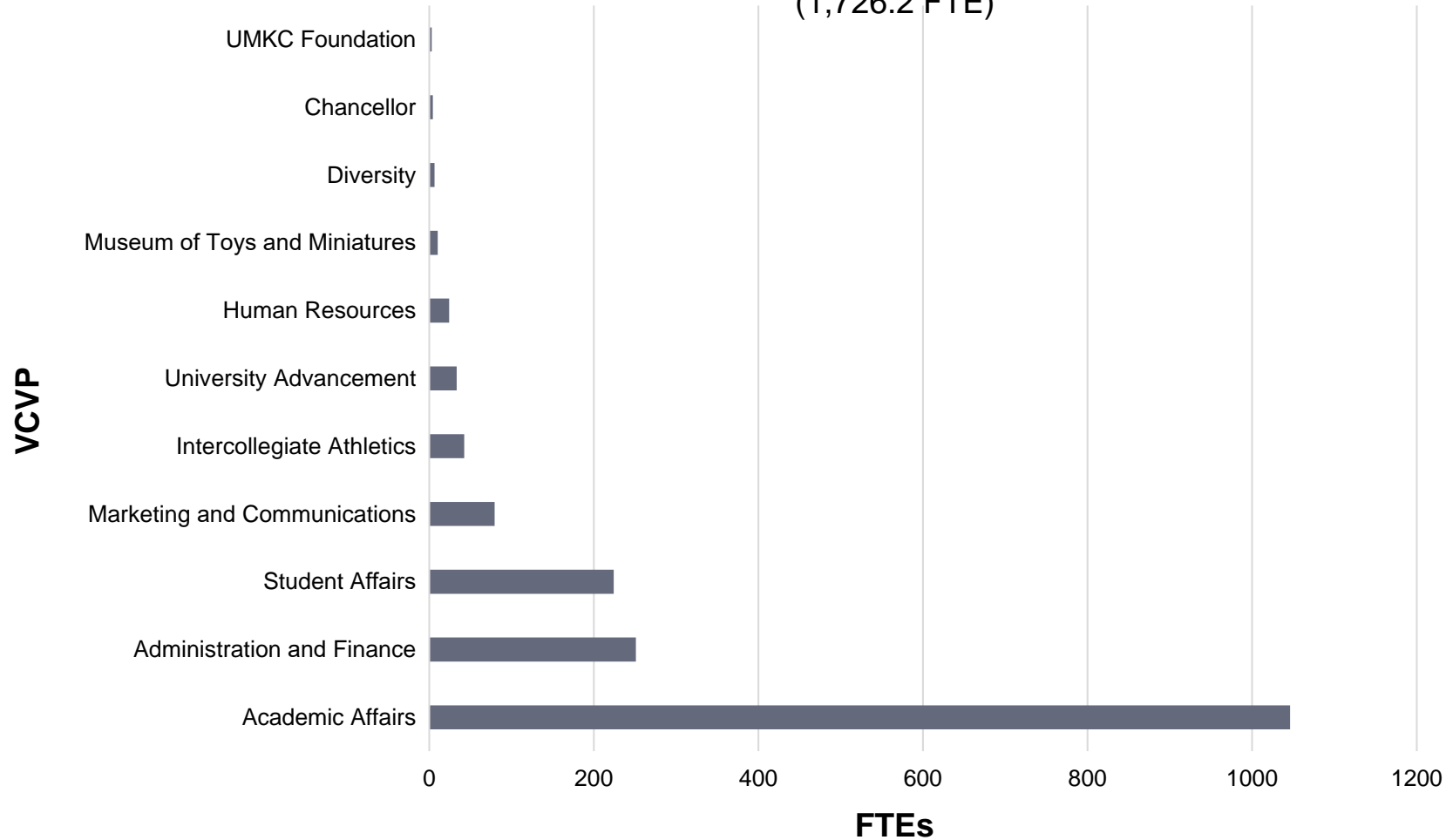
# Number of FTEs by Vice Chancellor/Vice President (VCVP)

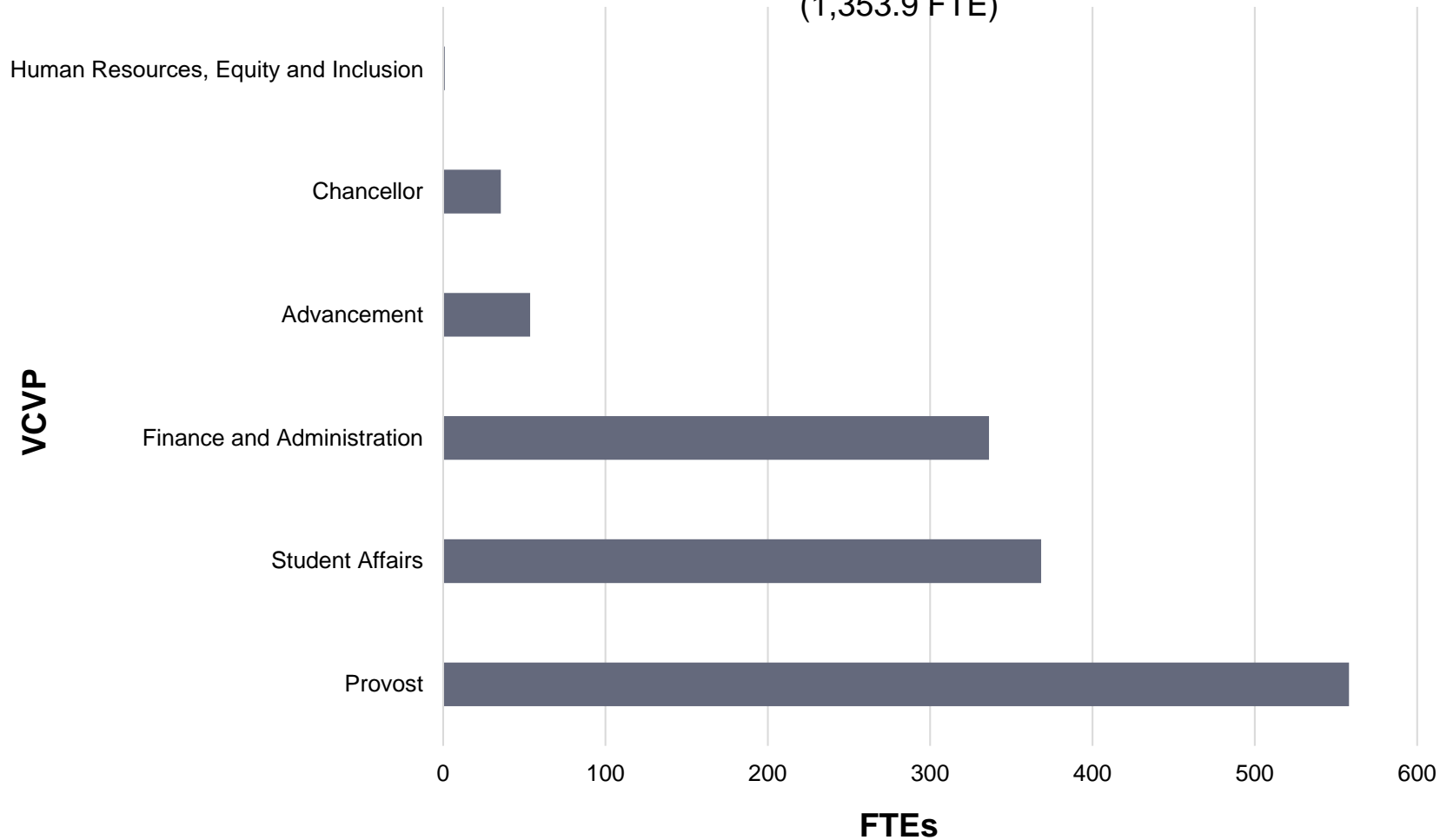

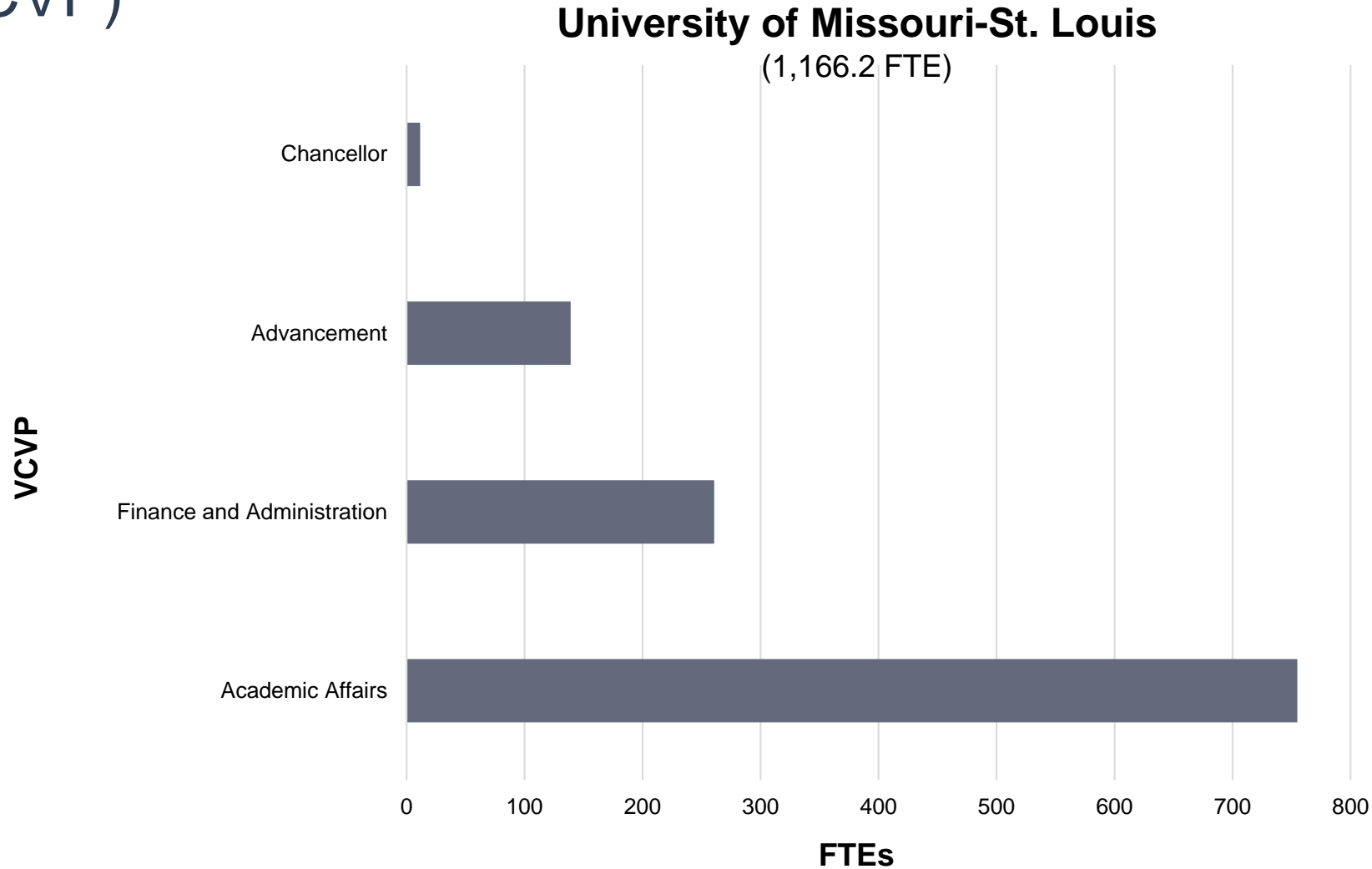
# Number of FTEs by Vice Chancellor/Vice President (VCVP)

## Missouri University of Science and Technology

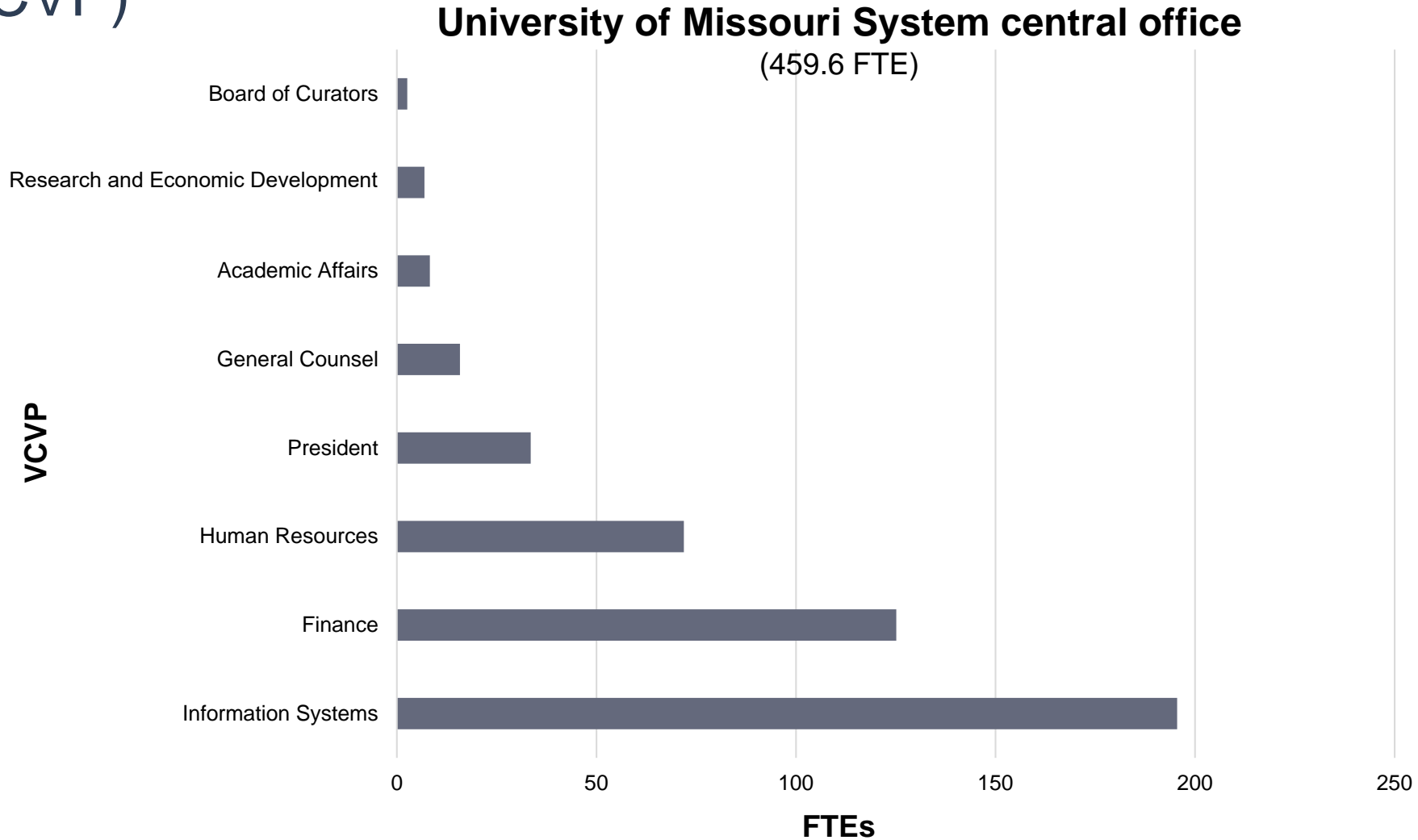

# Data Notes (1 of 5)

## Survey Population:

- The survey includes all staff and student positions and certain academic administrators (including provosts and any faculty with a primary appointment in the provost's office)
- Exclusions from the survey include all faculty, deans, graduate students with academic, teaching, or research appointments (GTAs/GRAs) and undergraduates with teaching or research appointments. The survey also excluded all employees who report organizationally to the hospital business unit.
- Summary views labelled "MU" include MU Extension and in-scope MU Health staff.

## Point in Time:

- The data represents the University's workforce at a point in time. Snapshot data used for the survey was generated from University employee data as of February 13, 2018.
- It is important to note the University workforce is ever changing and those changes are not reflected in this report. Data should be viewed as directional in nature, reflecting the relative distribution of work within departments.

- The complete survey taxonomy provided to employees to complete the survey can be found in an [information supplement](#) separate from this summary report.

# Data Notes (2 of 5)

## Allocation of Employee Data to Survey Elements:

- Annual employee FTE and salary were allocated to the lowest level of the survey (an activity) and aggregated to the larger process and function categories. If an employee recorded 1% of their time in a given activity, that activity would receive a 1% allocation of both salary and FTE reflective of that employee's position.
- Headcount shown is the number of unique individuals in that view of the data. Headcount does not reflect the amount of time spent, but rather the number of people in a given view.

## General Terminology:

- **Functional:** Describes the type of work done, not where in the organization an individual reports. For instance, if an employee who has a reporting line through Human Resources recorded in their survey that 10% of their time is spent in the Finance function, 10% of that employee's time would be reported in Finance in a functional view.
- **Organizational:** Describes where an individual reports in the organization, not the type of work performed. For instance, if an employee who has a reporting line through Human Resources recorded in their survey that 10% of their time is spent in the Finance function, the 10% of that employee's time would be reported in Human Resources in an organizational view.



# Data Notes (3 of 5)

## Data Definitions:

- **Full-time equivalent (FTE):** A unit of measure where a value of 1.0 is equivalent to a full-time worker. Values displayed in this report reflect the FTE coded in the University's HR system tied to each position. For instance, a worker who works 20 hours in a 40-hour work week would be described as 0.5 FTE. FTE serves as a proxy for work effort.
- **Headcount:** The number of unique individuals included in a data view. Following the example above, a worker who works 20 hours in a 40-hour work week would be described as a headcount of 1. Similarly, in a Functional style view (e.g., Finance), a worker who allocated 1% of work effort into Finance would still be described as a headcount of 1.
- **Gross Salary:** The sum of the hourly or monthly amounts paid to employees over the course of a year. All dollars displayed are annual amounts exclusive of any benefits.

## Level of Detail:

- Employees with split appointments who submitted responses are allocated organizationally by primary role. Data is a sum of all of an employee's positions.
- The primary appointment is the position designated with the highest FTE allocation in the University's HR system and follows an employee's supervisor.
- Functional teams, comprised from representatives from each campus, created the survey taxonomy for their respective functional area using varying levels of specificity based on the approach of each particular team.

# Data Notes (4 of 5)

Information submitted by an individual employee is considered an employee record and is treated accordingly with regard to privacy.

## **Supervisor Completions:**

Supervisors were permitted to complete a survey on behalf of positions in their reporting line in the following scenarios:

- **Vacancies:** Supervisors completed a survey on behalf of open, budgeted, full-time positions and positions where the incumbent employee was in leave status.
- **Temporary and seasonal positions:** Temporary and seasonal positions were accounted for via a pooling process. The supervisor of a temporary or seasonal position completed a survey reflecting the work efforts of that position behalf of employees in that position. The representative survey was then replicated to account for the number of individuals across each unique position utilizing the pooling process.
- **Employee incompletes:** Supervisors were given the opportunity to complete a survey for any employee who failed to complete a survey for their position by the March 2, 2018 deadline.

# Data Notes (5 of 5)

## About the Data:

- The information in this report tells us about positions involved in administrative work and how much is being done, but does not provide us with a view of how well a specific activity is performed or how important an activity may be.
- Information contained in this report represents a single data point; many times, decisions require multiple points of information and additional context.

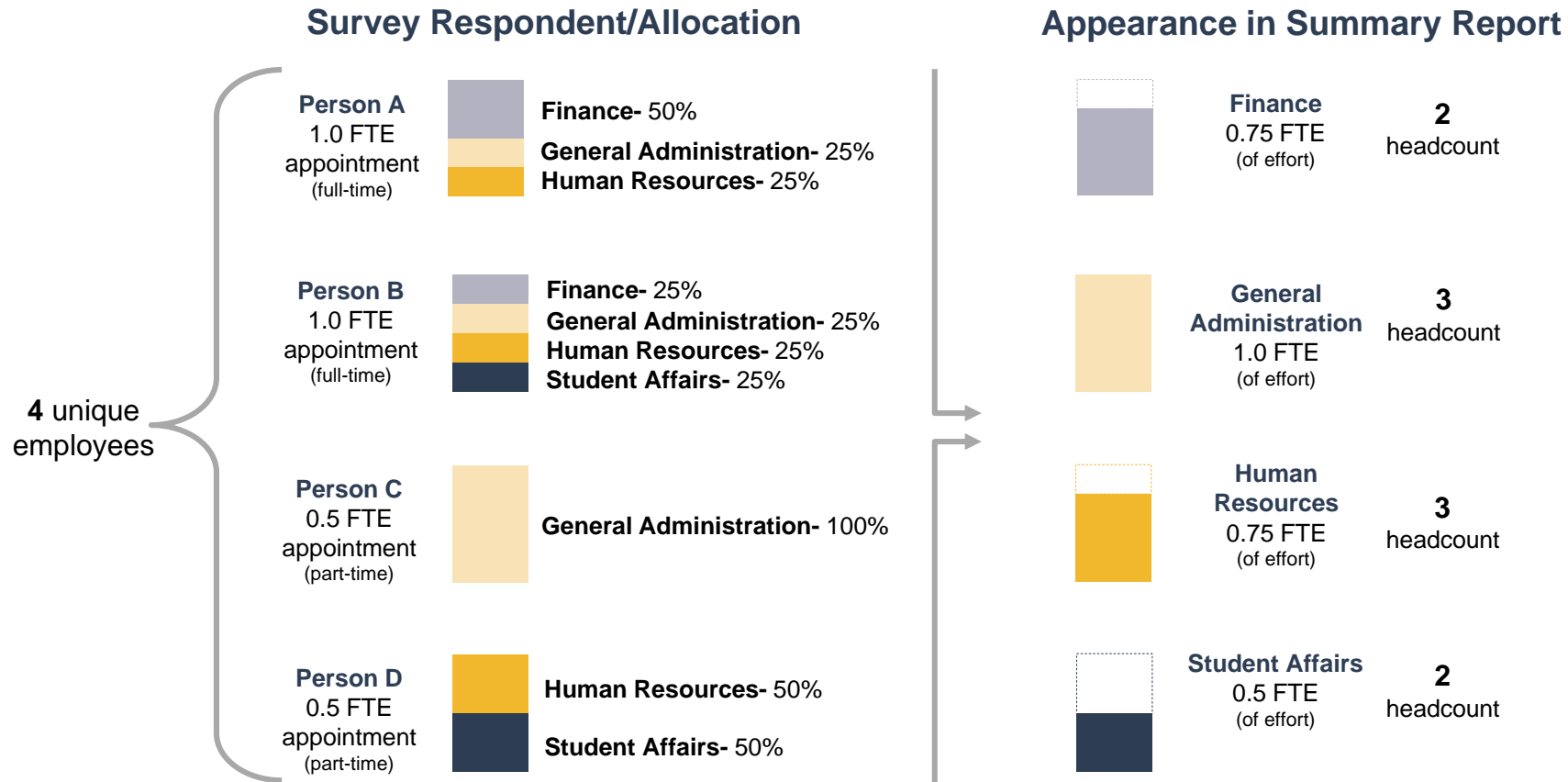
# Functional View

# How to Read (Functional Views)

- This section of the report displays information based on the type of work performed, not where in the organization individual employees report.
- The “Top 10” views of process and activity show the highest 10 processes and activities within the function based on the amount of FTE allocated to a particular process or activity.
- The “Top 10” job families view shows the top job families of individuals performing work based on FTE. This shows the categories of jobs performing the majority of the work for a given function.
- The “Top 10” organizational view shows the top sections of the organization where the employees performing the work report. This view is at the organizational level beneath the chancellor, so “Provost” includes all colleges and schools.
- In all views, salary remains the pro rata share of salary and FTE remains the pro rata share of FTE, but the headcount is the number of unique individuals performing the work.
- The complete survey taxonomy provided to employees to complete the survey can be found in an information supplement separate from this summary report.

# How to Read (Understanding FTE)

The FTE coded in the HR system for an individual employee appointment translates proportionally to the FTE values in these summary views, while headcount remains a consistent measure.



**For instance:**  
 Three of the individuals in this example allocated work in the General Administration function. Two have a full-time appointment and one has a part-time appointment.

When reading the summary view, one would say "The three individuals' work effort in General Administration is equivalent to one full-time position."
