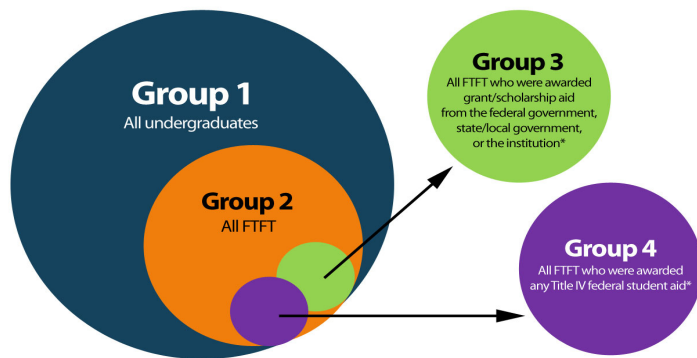
## Overview
