He received his Ph.D. from Indiana University in 1998 and has served on the faculties at the University of California, Irvine, the University of Southern California, and the University of Missouri – St. Louis. He is also a Certified Public Accountant in Missouri.

Steve has won several research and teaching awards including the American Accounting Association's Accounting Horizons Best Paper Award, Indiana University's Lieber Teaching Associate Award, University of Missouri-St. Louis Chancellor's Award for Teaching Excellence, and the Missouri Society of CPAs' Outstanding Educator Award. In 2019, he received the American Institute of CPAs Distinguished Accomplishment in Accounting Education award. He has published articles in academic journals including The Accounting Review, Accounting Horizons, the Journal of Accounting and Public Policy, Research in Accounting Regulation, the Journal of Accounting and the Public Interest, the Journal of Accountancy, the CPA Journal, and the Financial Analysts' Journal. He co-authored "The CPA Profession: Opportunities, Responsibilities, and Services," which is published by the American Institute of CPAs. Steve currently serves as Associate Editor of Accounting Horizons and previously served as Associate Editor of Research in Accounting Regulation.

Steve has spoken at high schools across Missouri about financial literacy, career planning, and personal finance. He has also served as Chair of the Board of the Missouri Society of CPAs (MOCPA) Education Foundation and the not-for-profit SMART Corporation. The MOCPA Education Foundation raises scholarship funds for accounting students, and supports University accounting professors across Missouri. The SMART Corporation manages a scholarship portfolio for an industry group.

Away from the University, Steve enjoys spending time with family, working the New York Times Crossword Puzzle, playing sports, reading history, and visiting beaches.
